I had a quick look at this – it seems comprehensive. As the environment section rep for the scheme, can you have a quick look and feedback to Shane when you get a chance.

I expect the cost of the surveys and assessments will start to become disproportionate to the scale of the proposed works but I assume this has been discussed within the steering group.

I envisage that with a number of NPWS people on the steering group, it should have sufficient environmental oversight anyway, hence if you don't have time to get too involved, it's a scheme where environment section could reduce our input to a minimum but we can adjust depending on how complex it becomes.
