I visited this site on Friday last and there are approximately 12 mature mixed broadleaf trees felled and removed. There are still a number of trees remaining on site that appear healthy. 9 of the trees felled would be more than 100ft from any building.

I saw an Advertisement notice on the ground and adjacent to the site belonging to Gourley Auctioneers, Site for Sale.

I am unable to establish if PP was obtained and I am enclosing the Donegal Co Co Planning Map.

Are you able to check up on any further relevant information please. The townland is Ardmore.
