Dear Sirs,

I am the registered owner of lands that are designated at Our Lady's Island Lake SAC with Site Code 000704. I attach herewith completed application for consent to carry out works on my lands that are within the SAC, SPA & NHA.

The following are the attachments with this application;

- 2. Copy of ArcGIS Map of the Relevant Areas
- 3. Photo Profile of the Relevant Areas

The lands where I propose to undertake the works have been in my ownership for almost ten years now and in this time I have used the areas for rough grazing of my bovines over the summer grazing months. The photos I attach illustrate that the areas for the proposed works and I trust you will note the primary flora in this area is grass and old pasture. My ambition is to reseed with grass to both improve the grass quality and to form a level seedbed which will facilitate mowing with a conventional mower. I currently participate in the GLAS agri-environment scheme and have a LPIS Parcel dedicated to wild bird cover nearby. This I hope illustrates that I am conscious of the importance of the area to the native bird species occupying Our Lady's Island Lake.

The area hatched in green on the attached map and set out in detail in the attached photos does not in my opinion provide any specific ecological benefit to the birds occupying SAC 000704. Moreover there is no nesting evident in the area where I propose to undertake the works. The reestablishment of a new pasture will not I believe damage the integrity of the lake or the habitat for the birds.

The area hatched in blue on the attached map mainly comprises of heavy foliage, briars and bushes. Again I do not believe that this area provides a habitat for the birds occupying the lake and works that I propose to undertake will have little impact in the vicinity. You will note from the map that I have marked in red the current arable perimeter of my lands and the clearing of the area in blue will simply make the arable line consistent and parallel with the other arable fields. I propose to retail a hedgerow to the eastern side as this boundary hedgerow offers shelter from the prevalent winds from the lake.

The works that I propose will not in my opinion have an undue negative impact on SAC 000704 and I hope that you will understand the benefit that these works would have for my farming enterprise. As referenced above I believe I contribute to the eco-system by participating in schemes such as GLAS. On my farm holding I have also participated in other schemes such as the AEOS and REPS with measures such as planting new hedgerows, preservation and protection of watercourses from bovines and the establishment of bird and bat boxes.

I trust you will consider my application with reference to the fact that the works I propose are a safe and reasonable distance from the high water mark of the lake and will not threaten the various plant species as outlined in the site synopsis as published by the Department of Arts, Heritage and the Gaeltacht for Our Lady's Island Lake SAC.




Green Hatched Area for Proposed Ploughing & Re-seeding in Grass





