Please find attached, an application received by this Department on 02nd June 2020 from seeking the consent of the Minister for Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media, under Regulation 30 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011, to carry reclamation of lands for agriculture and reseeding an area of lakeshore at

This Department has reviewed the application and, for the following reasons, is of the opinion that the proposed work is an activity that comes under the European Communities (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Agriculture) Regulations 2011:

The proposed activity falls within the Regulation 3(1)(b) project category, "commencing to use uncultivated land or semi-natural areas for intensive agriculture", and the activity is likely to have a significant effect on a European Site (Lady's Island Lake Special Area of Conservation (SAC) (Site Code:00 0704)), alone or in combination with other plans or projects.

The activity is deemed likely to have a significant effect on a European Site due to its location within the Lady's Island Lake SAC, alone or in combination with other plans or projects, and because;

Water quality impacts, in combination with other water quality pressures, are likely to be significant. Loss of lagoon habitat is likely to be significant. Conclusion; likely significant effects cannot be ruled out in relation to lagoon habitat in the Lady's Island Lake Special Area of Conservation.
