Summary: The purpose of the visit was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were been carried out on lands at Walsh Island, The Forge, Co. Offaly (Appendix 1).
- ii) To determine what activity and the location of the activities been undertaken was carried out at during recent months.

Findings of site visit of 12/05/2022: The following was noted during the visit:

- Preparatory works were ongoing on the peatland.
- Peat harvesting machinery was noted and a tractor with a tiller was recently used on the peatland (Appendix 2).
- Stockpiles of milled peat were noted at a loading area adjacent to the main entrance.
- We spoke to two men who were driving machines on the peatland and they informed us they were working for Bulrush.
