I have attached a cross compliance report on the above.

I contacted Jane Gilleran IFI earlier also. She was able to inform me that the current flow rate at that location is 2.003 cubic metres per second (or 2003 litres) while the 95%ile flow is 3.67. The average abstraction rate for the machine in question is 10 litres per second.
