

Re: General Felling Licence application from Coillte Teoranta in respect of lands at Garvagh Glebe, Co Leitrim. Ref: GFL SO100009, GFL LM080009, GFL LM060009.

2nd March 2009

I have carried out a desk top study in relation to this application before visiting the property involved on Friday 27th February 2009. The application has been made in order to facilitate the construction of Garvagh Glebe Windfarm the site being located on Corry Mountain to the West of Lough Allen in County Leitrim. The proposed windfarm involves the construction of thirteen wind turbines at the Garvagh Glebe site by Hibernian Wind Power Limited in partnership with Coillte Teoranta the total capital investment being in the region of 10 million Euro. The project has gained full planning from the local authority Leitrim County Council and an Environmental Impact Statement (report PO4J004-R3 was prepared by ESB International on behalf of the partnership. In relation to the identification and assessment of landscape and visual effects, I have confined my investigation to ascertaining the effects of the proposed clearfell of existing plantation forest on the landscape Character of the area.

The assessment of effects aims to:

1. Identify systematically the likely effects of the development.
2. Identify the mitigation measures used to reduce, remedy or compensate for those effects.
3. Estimate the magnitude of the effects
4. Finally provide an assessment of the nature and significance of these effects in a logical and reasonable manner.

Nature of Effects.

The proposal involves the clearfelling of predominantly Lodgepole pine crops and subsequent reforestation of the areas with the exception of the Wind turbine footprints and new access roads. Cumulative effects of the development occur over an area of approximately 153 hectares. The area in question is best described as remote upland; there are distant views of the development from viewpoints along county roads outside the village of Drumkeeran. The impact of proposed clearfell in my opinion is not as significant as the impact of the existing wind farms in the vicinity. The associated indirect effects of the development include the upgrading of the road infrastructure, gravel pits, associated peat extraction and construction of electricity sub-station, these effects have already been dealt with by the Local Authority as part of the development control in the planning process. In terms of the clearfell proposals the cumulative landscape and visual effects resulting from changes to the landscape are mainly negative but the effect is temporary as the reforestation affords the opportunity to introduce improved forest landscape design plans over the area and introduce more biodiversity to the area. In one instance the removal of conifers away from the ridge line is positive and a major improvement on the previous design. The two principal criteria in determining the significance are the scale or magnitude of effect and the environmental sensitivity of the location. In my opinion the scale of the effect in the landscape is significant due to the size of the proposed clearfell areas. The proposals have a large effect on an area that should be considered as less

sensitive. The wind turbines are the most visually intrusive feature any clearfell operations will add to this effect but will be only temporary (5 years).

The forest itself comprise of mainly poor quality Lodgepole Pine, within the forest estate changes in the vicinity have been numerous resulting in a greater spread across age classes. The main views of the Windfarm are towards the East and North-east over a distance of 1.5km. There are no dominant views from the west due to topography and other forest cover. There are limited views from the West-northwest and South-west for about 4km, the visual impact in these areas is not significant.

There are distant views of the development from the East and Southeast but because of the distances involved the visual impact is low and not significant.

There are no significant changes from recognised viewpoints or amenity routes. The number of people likely to be effected by changes to the landscape character of the area is small, only three residences in the vicinity of the proposals were identified none were occupied. In terms of landscape impacts in my opinion the proposals will have a significant impact on the landscape but this in an area that is not significant in terms of its visual qualities, this type of landscape is abundant locally, is neither unique or attractive in its current state. The major decision to grant planning permission has already been determined and where I would be critical of the scoping of the original EIS, but on balance the construction of a wind farm has more beneficial effects than negative effects in terms of the environment.

I recommend granting of the felling licence subject to the provision of supplementary information.

1. Provision of a Forest Landscape Design Plan for the entire project area by a suitably qualified Landscape Architect with experience in forestry.
2. The provision of assessments of peat stability for proposed Garvagh Glebe Windfarm.
3. The provision of Aerial photography, Forest Inventory and TRC data including fell year maps for the areas concerned.
4. Evidence of stakeholder consultation and correspondence with the Regional Fisheries Board and the Local Authority.
5. Details of water sampling gathered to date and an outline of proposals designed to mitigate potential adverse impact of, increased runoff, nutrient loading, and siltation of watercourses.

Windfarms – Tree felling - Coillte –

Context:

In general, applications for the Felling Licenses for trees in the footprint of wind turbines and to enable associated road development does not pose major misgivings.

However the current General Felling License application for Garvagh Glebe is to clearfell a much more substantial area than these footprints. It is a more substantial cumulative area than would be countenanced normally as good forest practice.

It is noted that that the EIS for the development has not adequately addressed the issues that should be raised in connection with such a clearfell.

Introduction:

- Maps of SACs/SPAs, NHAs, pNHAs in the locality.

- Landscape designation per the County Development Plan.
- Water body characterisation per the Water Framework Directive.

Cumulative

- All areas (including the felling associated with the windfarm) where tree felling is proposed in the future 5 years.
- All areas felled in the past 4 years in the locality
- All areas replanted in the past 4 years.
- All areas in receipt of fertiliser in the past 4 years.

Potential impacts/mitigation:

- The impact the felling and any replanting may have on the redesign plan for the forest per applications for GFL already submitted and/or granted.
- The potential impacts, mitigation measures and monitoring measures (in respect of any harvesting and replanting in combination with other developments associated with this development) in relation to soil stability, water quality (particularly with regard to sedimentation and eutrophication), landscape, ecology/habitats and monuments.
- The economic impact due to the reduced forest rotation (where applicable) and on planned future rotations.
- Screening to address potential impacts on SACs/SPAs per the Habitats Directive and Habitats Regulations.



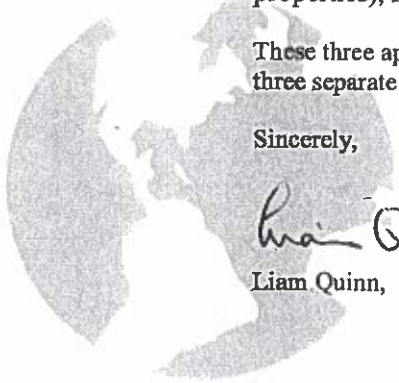

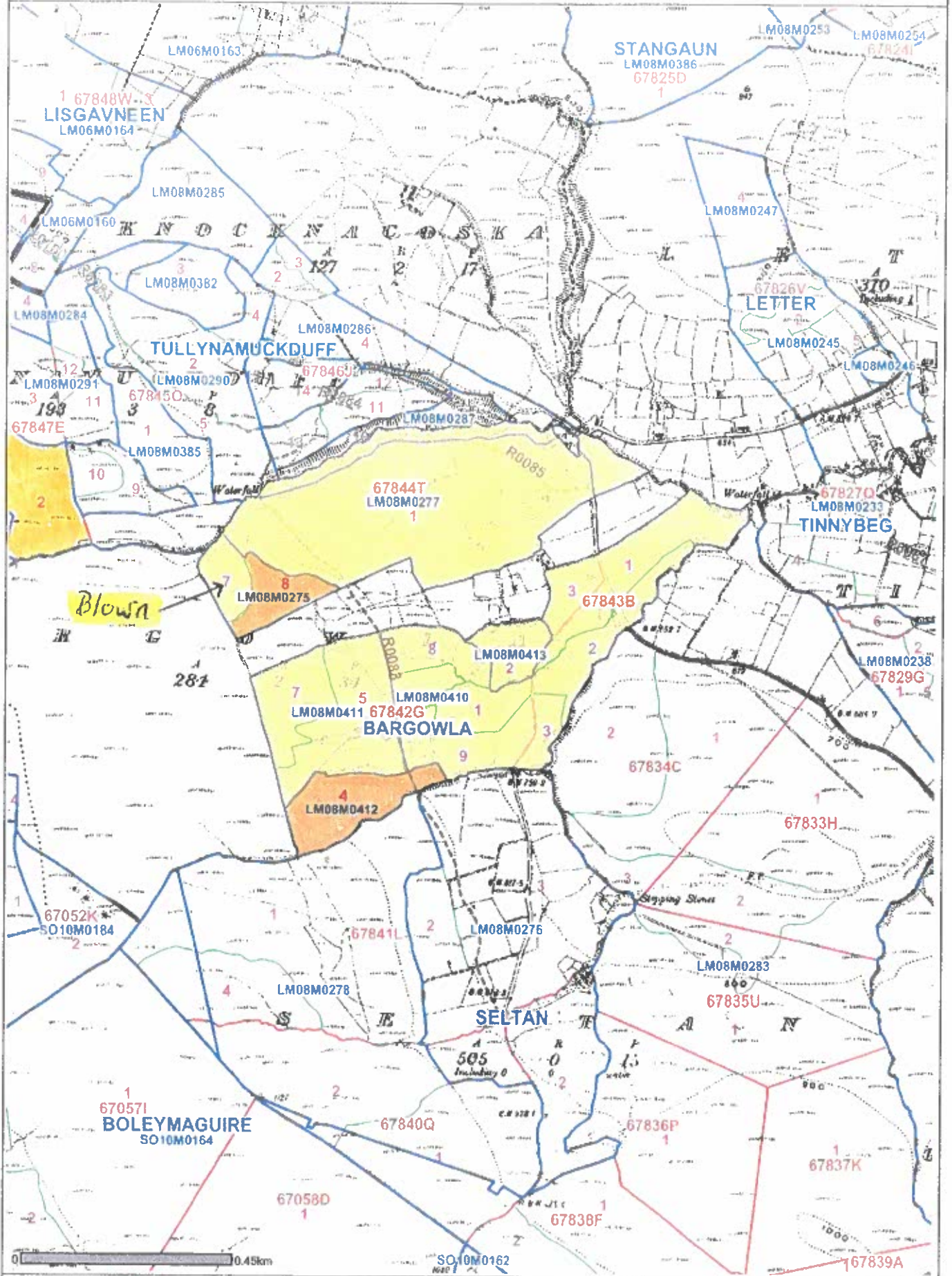

BARGOWLA, LM08, GARVAGH GLEBE WINDFARM

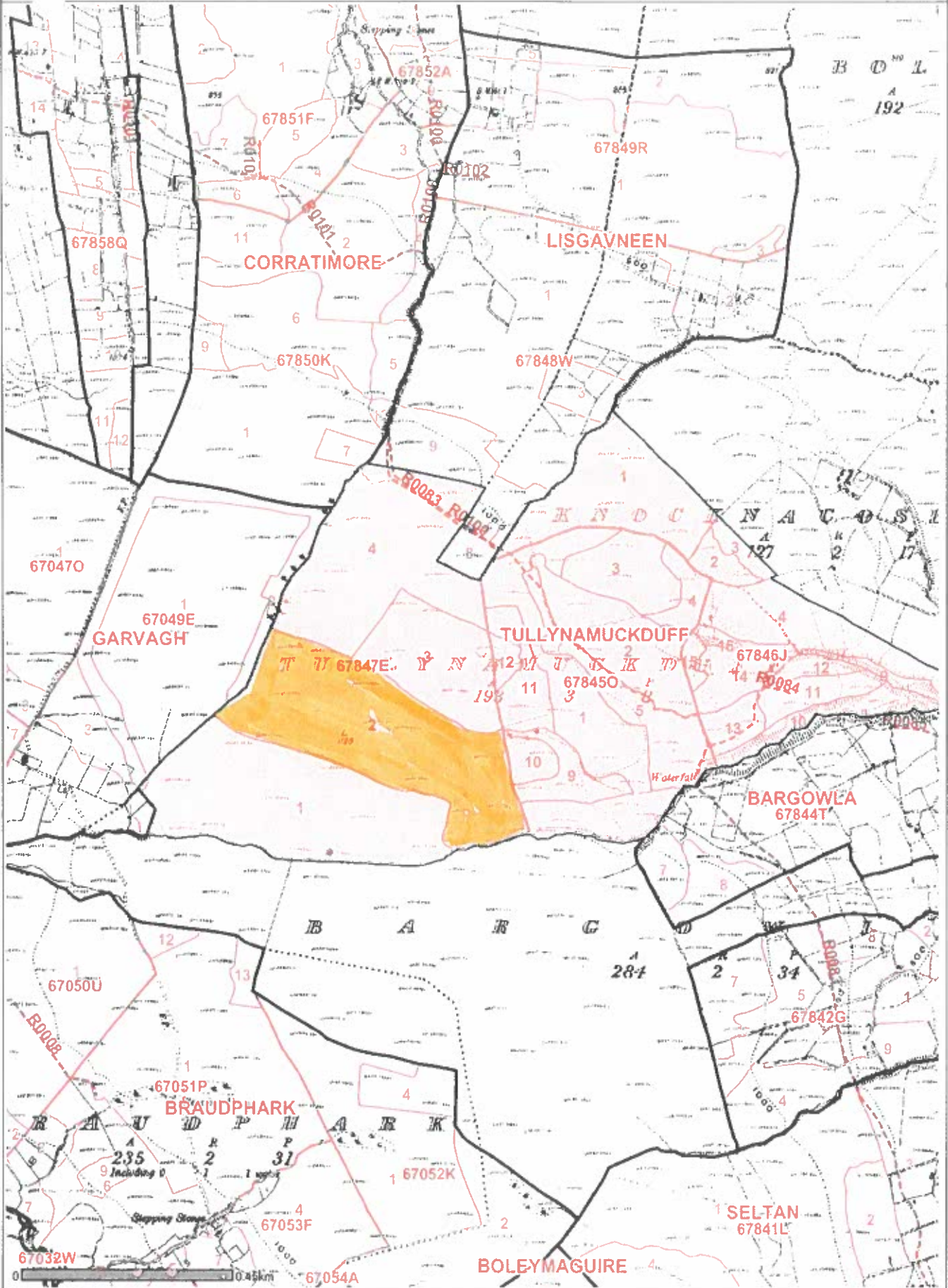

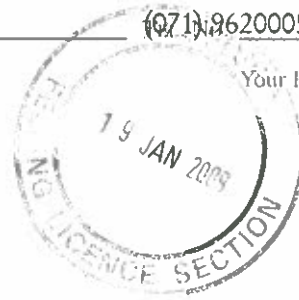

Further to an examination of the relevant maps, the site is located within an area of High Visual Amenity as identified in the County Development Plan 2003-2009.

There are no Tree Preservations Orders in respect of trees on the lands proposed for felling.

The site does not impact on a recorded monument as listed for protection under Section 12 of the National Monuments (Amendments) Act 1994.

In terms of the Landscape Capacity to Accommodate Forestry the site appears to be located within an area identified in the County Development Plan as being an area of Low Capacity/High Sensitivity. The Plan states that 'new afforestation in these areas will be strongly discouraged and where possible the existing area under forestry will be reduced.' Due to the foregoing, the Planning Authority requests that the policies and objectives of the Plan be considered.

This Planning Authority wishes to make the following observations relating to the proposed felling of the trees, which should be taken into consideration as appropriate:

1. Prior to commencement of tree felling and transportation of felled timber, the landowner and/or transport operator shall be required to submit a proposed transport scheme showing details of location of the activity, volume of produce to be transported, details of vehicles to be used, routes to be used and the timing of the operations. The Local Authority reserves the right to specify alternative routing. You are advised to consult with the District Engineer, Dromahair Area Office in this regard (Leitrim County Development 2003-2009, Section 3.03.09).



With regard to any proposed road the forestry service should be advised as follows:

- Any proposed road would not be considered exempted development if the following was applicable:

Article 9 (1) (Planning and Development Act 2000) - Development to which article 6 relates shall not be exempted development for the purposes of the Act –

(a) if the carrying out of such development would

(ii) consist of or comprise the formation, laying out or material widening of a means of access to a public road the surfaced carriageway of which exceeds 4 metres in width,

(iii) endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard or obstruction of road users.



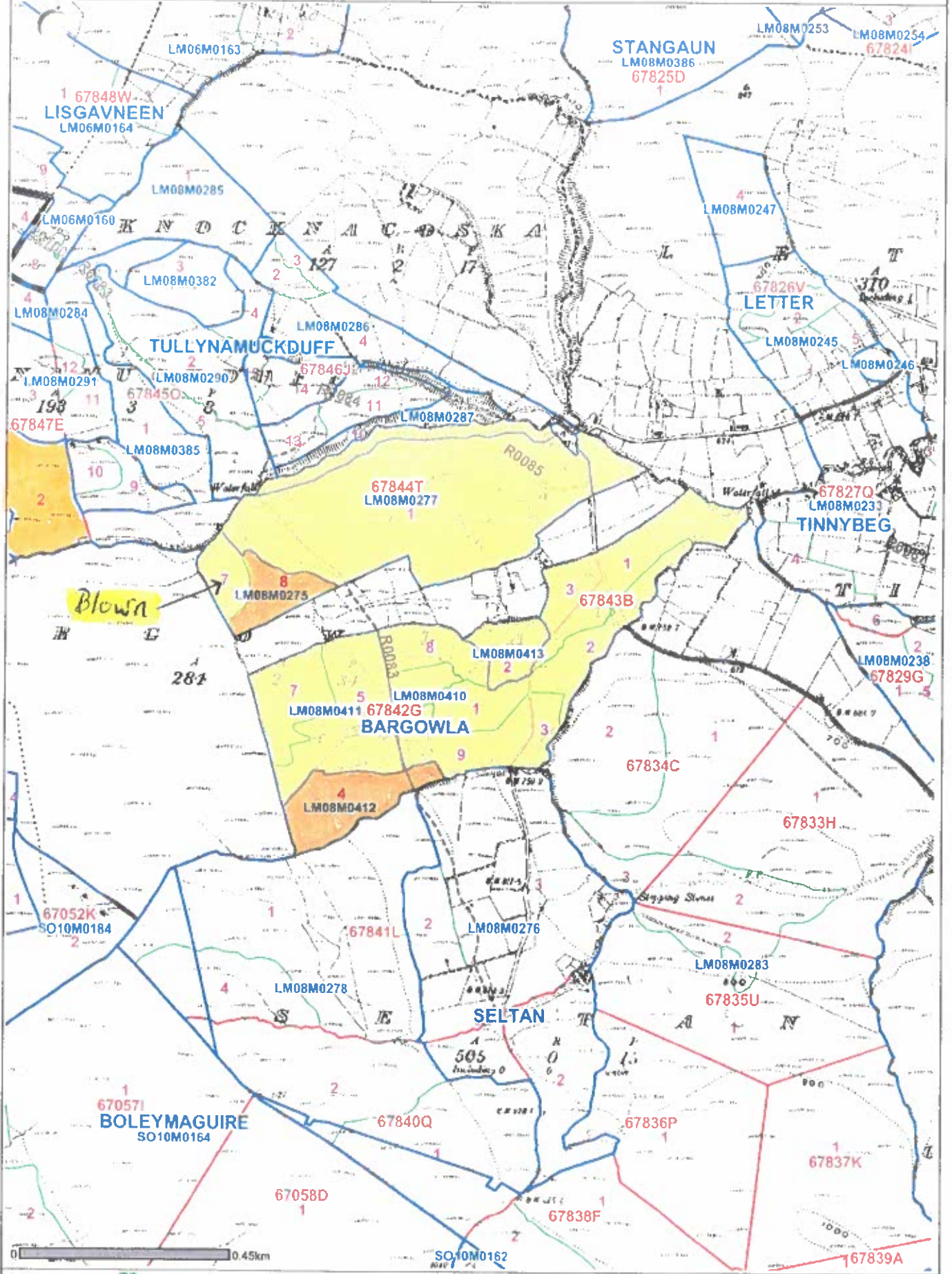

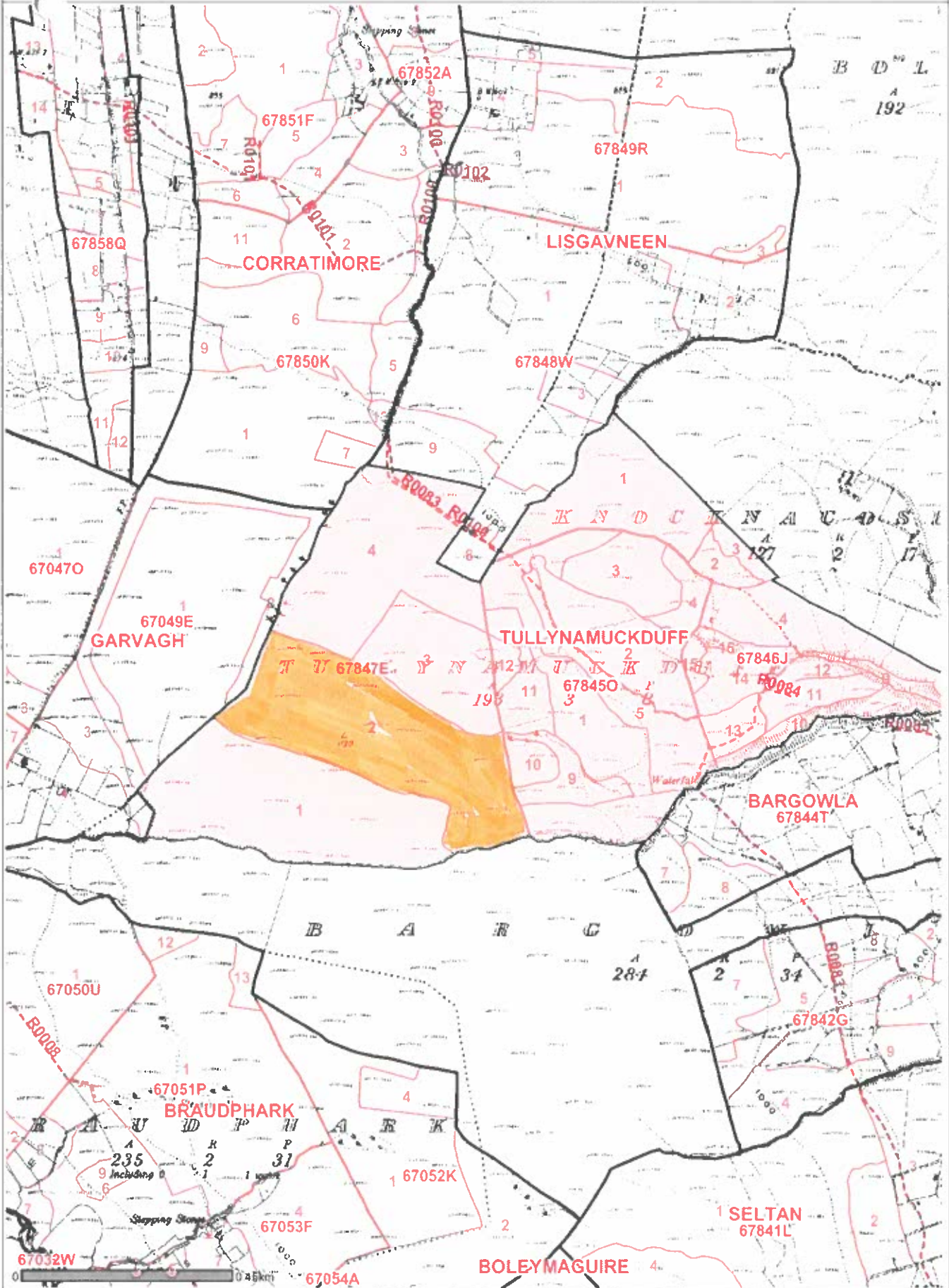
