I refer to your request dated 15/08/2023 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, for records held by this FOI Body.

I, Dr. Philip Buckley, have now made a final decision to grant your request on 05/09/2023 accordingly, a copy of the records is now enclosed including a copy of the schedule to these records.

With regards to the question below

Q1: The estimated cost of the Osprey release efforts for the duration of the programme.
Please see attached record 1 for the cost apportioned for this project for this year.

It is anticipated that the cost for this programme will be of the order of €200,000 per year for the remaining four years

Right of Appeal
