Summary: The purpose of the visit was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were being carried out by one or more parties at the above address in Co Westmeath.
- ii) The site visit commenced on lands where excavation, turning and stockpiling of sodpeat following extraction activity was noted.

Findings of site visit of 23/05/2023: The following was noted during the visit:

- No peat excavation was noted to be taking place on the peatland during the visit.
- Large sod peat was noted to be stacked and left on the peatland for drying.
- An attachment for excavating large sod peat was noted on the peatland and it had the letters [REDACTED] on it.
- An area of the peatland at the southern end had been recently cleared and an excavator was noted to be parked there.
