



SITE VISIT REPORT

Purpose of Site Visit: Peat Extraction in Co. Kildare
Site Address: Ballinderry, Carbury, Co. Kildare
Date of Visit: 18/06/24
Times of Visit: 1550 to 1700
Visit Criteria: Peat extraction investigation

Summary: The purpose of the visit was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were being carried out on lands at the above address in Ballinderry, Carbury, Co. Kildare (Appendix 1).
- ii) To determine what activities and the location of the activities being undertaken were carried out.

Findings of site visit of 18/06/24: The following was noted during the visit:

- Aerial footage and photos were taken by EPA inspectors throughout the visit from off-site and on-site locations.
- Milled peat extraction was noted to be taking place during the visit. Two tractors and trailers (Bog Hogs) were collecting milled peat on the south western part of the peatland and the milled peat was then transported back to the bagging/processing plant area.
- Significant dust emissions were noted to be arising from the milled peat extraction activities, particularly as the milled peat was being transported from the South Western part of the peatland back up to the bagging/processing plant area.
- Machinery/equipment for extracting and harvesting peat was noted to be parked adjacent to the bagging/processing plant at the site.
- Large stockpiles of milled peat were noted adjacent to the bagging/processing plant and an excavator was working on top of the stockpiles.
- Significant sediment build up was noted in the drainage network at the South eastern corner of the peatland.
