**Purpose of Site Visit:** Peat Extraction on bogs in Co. Roscommon

**Site Address:** Clonshask, Ballydangan Co Roscommon

**Date of Visit:** 20/03/24

**Visit Criteria:** Peat extraction investigation

**Summary:** The purpose of the visits was to

- i) Ascertain whether peat extraction activities were been carried out by Tully Peat or its agents on lands owned and controlled by Tully Peat and/or its agents in Co Roscommon.
- ii) The site visit commenced on lands where excavation, turning, stockpiling and removal off-site of large sod peat following extraction activity was noted.

**Findings of site visit of 20/03/24:** The following was noted during the visit:

- A significant quantity of large sod peat had been extracted and left on the peatland for drying.
- No peat harvesting machinery or equipment was noted on the peatland.
- No peat extraction was taking place during the visit.
