
Dear Ms McDonnell,
In relation to your correspondence sent by email on 5th July 2024 in respect of unauthorised commercial peat extraction in County Longford and associated Proposed Direction by the EPA, I wish to make the following observations.

It is proposed to carry out a review of the following relevant listed Bogs in County Longford commencing in September 2024:

- a. Coolcraff;
- b. Clooniher and Annaghcooleen;
- c. Derrymore, Trillickacurry and Ballymakeegan;
- d. Lisnagrish, Lissanure, Clontymullan and Aghnavelogue.

This review will consist of further site visits to each Bog. Where deemed necessary the owners/operators shall be required to prepare and submit a detailed Appropriate Assessment screening report and determination statement - Stage 1 and Stage 2 (Natura Impact Statement Report), given the subject site location and proximity to nearby Natura 2000 sites, including SAC and SPA.
