I would be grateful if you would issue the attached inspection letter re. LM09-FL0064.

Also, could you issue an amendment to this licence which includes the following new conditions, thanks;

-All site workers shall be briefed by a designated and suitably qualified person before commencement of operations, to inform all of how to recognise the invasive species of concern; to identify where the species is known to occur; where the invasive species is absent to protect these areas;

-Utilise the reach of the harvesting machine to fell and remove trees from infested areas, taking care not to drag foliage or other plant parts into non infested areas. The focus will be on making sure that no soil or vegetative material associated with the invasive species is moved from the infested area to another part of the site and beyond.

-Thoroughly check and if necessary, clean forest machinery prior to entering and leaving the site, for the purpose of preventing the spread of invasive species.
