Hi

I am fully supportive of the emerging preferred route and the scheme in general.

My only comments are that the greenway scheme needs to include links back to Kilcoole and Newcastle, as per the links in the GDA Cycle Network Plan.

It is well established from user surveys of other greenways that local residents will be the largest group using the facility. In this regard it is essential that proper links are included in the scheme to connect the greenway to Kilcoole and Newcastle. These could be along the existing local roads with a Quiet Road treatment applied as per TII's NCN strategy.

In addition it will be important that users can avail of loop routes and not just an out and back route. To this end the NTA's GDA network provides for these facilities and TII and the project team need to proactively engage with Wicklow County Council's Active Travel Team and the NTA to ensure that the GDA connections are progressed and delivered in the same timeframe as the greenway.

I have attached a map that shows the connections referred to above. As a minimum the links to Kilcoole and Newcastle should be included in the main Greenway scheme.
