To whom it may concern,

I am writing to object, in the strongest terms, to the proposed route for the Greystones to Wicklow so-called Greenway.

This is a route that has absolutely no regard for our wildlife, or the people who live along the Sea Road in Kilcoole, of which I am one.

My lane is accessed through the Kilcoole train carpark, which at the best of times is a nightmare to get through with dog walkers and commuters using the varark to access either the train station or the beach, on a sunny day this increases ten-fold.

Wicklow coco cannot think that its an acceptable plan to bring thousands of people, running, cycling, with prams and dogs, down a residential lane, on which there are 18 properties, that is no wider at any point that 3 metres.

How do I, or my neighbours, navigate getting in or out when we're faced with these crowds on a sunny day?

What if emergency services are needed?

This proposed route takes only one consideration in mind, its the easiest for construction and nothing else.

Aside from my own personal issues, a corridor cannot be allowed to be built through so much natural habitat, the in-calcuable damage that bringing that volume of people and dogs into will cause, is unbelievable.

Just because something can be done, doesn't mean it should.

Leave these areas alone, address coastal erosion, open the Greystones to Bray cliffwalk.
