I am a 3rd generation dairy farmer living at Leamore Newcastle. I am deeply concerned about the proposed route as it would have a huge impact on my farm and my livelihood. Firstly the Newcastle river passes along by my land and it silts up regularly and would have to be cleaned out. With the greenway in place, I wouldn't be able to do [this](#). My land gets flooded and Irish Rail are supposed to free up the estuary and they aren't doing what they promised. I cannot see that changing...actions speak louder than words. Secondly bog lands should be left for bio diversity. Geese are regularly feeding in this field. Thirdly, I would not give access to construction work on the Greenway from my farm as I need to have access to the fields and animals at all times. Fourthly, I am worried that walkers etc may throw things over the fence and cause harm to the cows. Finally, most of the locals around here would prefer to walk along the coast. This has been done for years. This inland route does not benefit Newcastle village and is taking away valuable land from working farms. I have no issue with the Greenway if it stays along by the coast/ railway track. Coastal erosion projects need to be accelerated.
