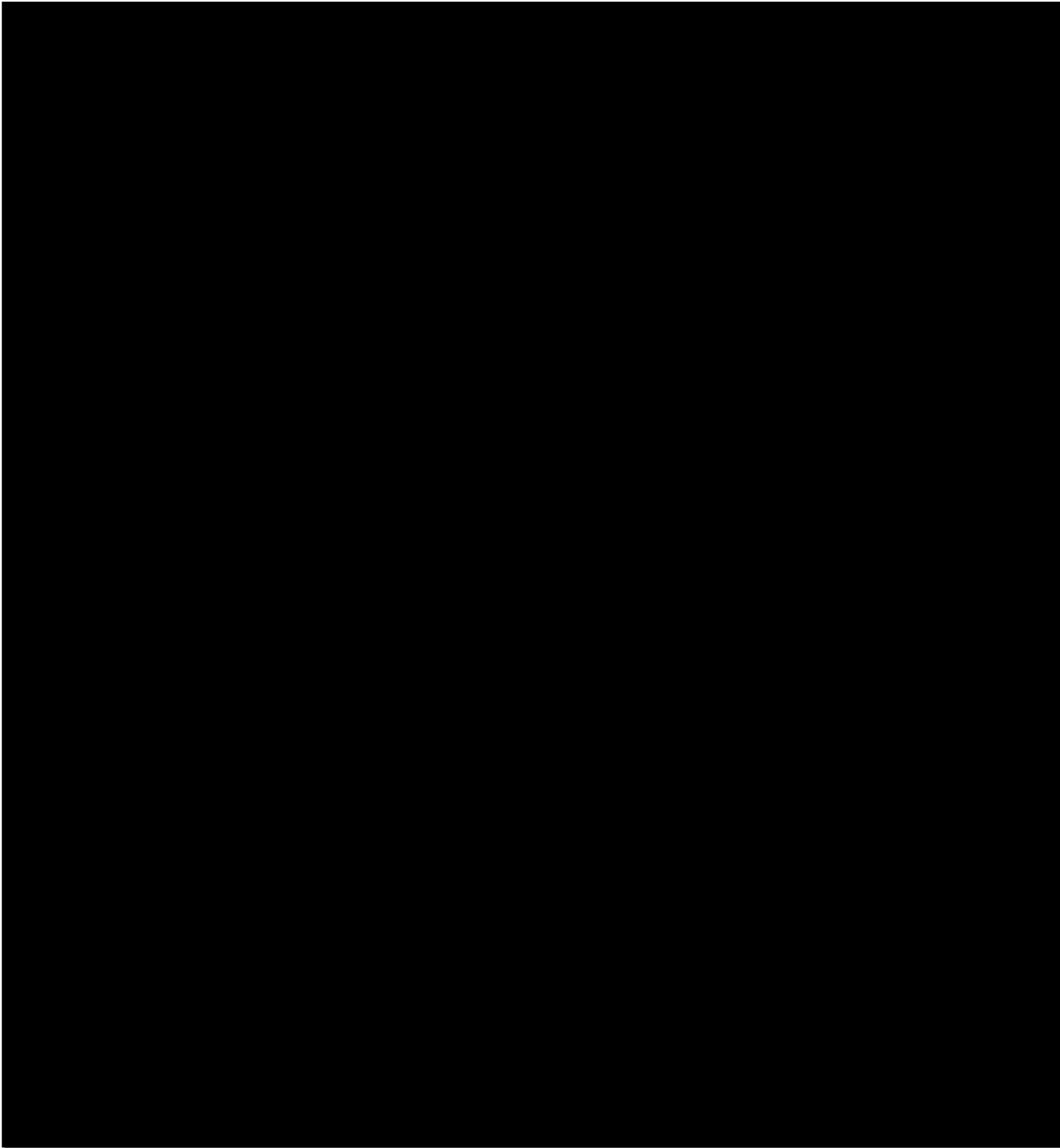


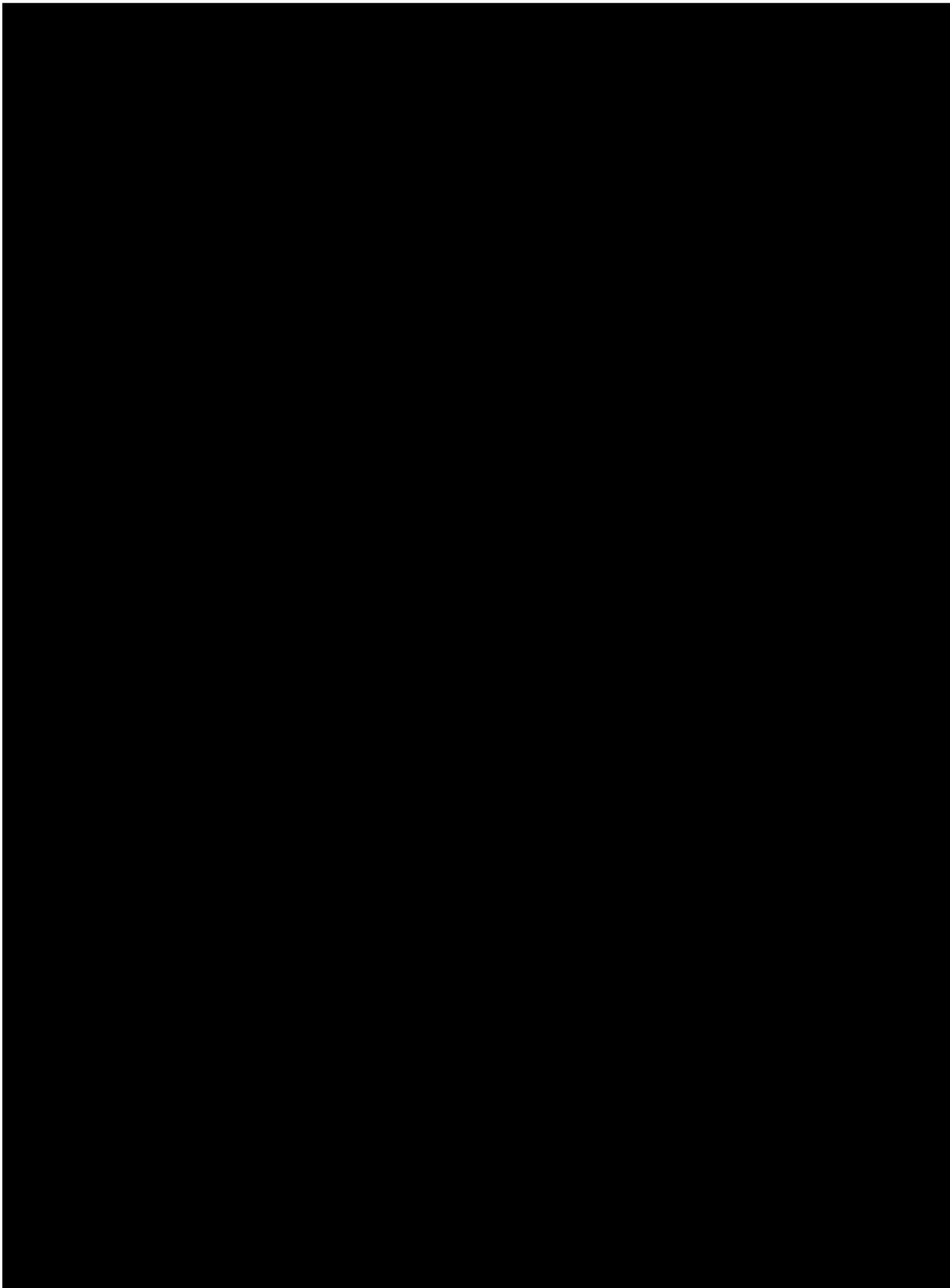

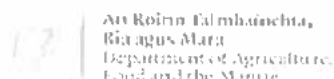

Hi Orla,

You probably remember that Coillte sent us a first concept note for the Western Peatlands project in 2019 and that we have paid some preparation costs for this since. Coillte have now submitted their updated concept note as a basis for applying for funding for the full project from the Department for this. ASG Savage has given his approval in principle, but we will now need to work out the details. I.e. we need to assess the proposal and then issue a detailed grant funding letter, if appropriate. Whenever you get a chance, would be great if you could have a look at the attached and let me know if you have any comments / observations from an Ecology point of view please.

I had a chat with Robbie about this a little while ago and Robbie suggested that we could take this opportunity to develop a DAFM Code of Good Practise for Conversion from Forests to Restored Peatlands and ask Coillte to contribute to this through information and data from their pilot project. This could be part of the T&Cs in the approval. Any thoughts you might have about this are of course much appreciated, too.

I am planning to collect comments over the next while and then summarise these for further discussion. Would you be interested to be part of the assessment group for this project? If you have too much on, no problem, just let me know please.

Hi all,

Please be informed that ASG Paul Savage has recently given approval in principle to Coillte that DAFM will fund Coillte's Western Peatlands Project. However, for Coillte to get full approval, we require a detailed project proposal (see my email below to Coillte) which we will then need to assess before funding approval can be

issued. Approval will probably be in the form of a detailed grant funding letter, including all terms & conditions that we think are required and necessary.

I had a quick chat with Robbie about this earlier and Robbie has suggested that we could take this opportunity to develop a DAFM Code of Good Practise for Conversion from Forests to Restored Peatlands and ask Coillte to contribute to this through information and data from their pilot project. This could be part of the T&Cs in the approval.

The reason why I am sending this email to you is that we will require to set up an assessment team following receipt of the proposal and I would like to invite you to be part of this, provided you have availability.

Could you confirm your availability to me by the end of this week please?
